Energy Management Obligations in 2018

In 2018 NORA met its Public Body Energy Management obligations set out in S.I. No. 426/2014 - European Union(Energy Efficiency) Regulations 2014

NORA continues to pursue its energy saving targets for 2020 through participation in SEAI's system for Energy Monitoring and Reporting.

Overview of Energy Usage in 2018

NORA's main energy use in 2018 was as follows:

NORA's office building -22.6 MWh were consumed at a carbon emission total of 8,700 kg.

Ringsend terminal -16.6 MWh were consumed at a carbon emission of 6,391 kg.

Tarbert terminal -76.8 MWh were consumed with a total carbon emissions of 29,565 kg.

Energy Management Actions in 2018

- Ongoing commitment to SEAI energy M&R programme.
- Commitment to the practical, technical and behavioural adjustments necessary to achieve energy savings.
- Continued implementation of NORA's Energy Management Plan.
- Installation of exterior LED lighting at NORA's Tarbert terminal
- Installation of 10kW solar energy generator at the Tarbert terminal completed in Q3 2018 to reduce net energy consumption and to cut CO₂ emissions.
