Energy Management Obligations in 2019

In 2019 NORA met its Public Body Energy Management obligations set out in S.I. No. 426/2014 - European Union(Energy Efficiency) Regulations 2014

NORA continues to pursue its energy saving targets for 2020 through participation in SEAI's system for Energy Monitoring and Reporting.

Overview of Energy Usage in 2019

NORA's main energy use in 2019 was as follows:

NORA's office building -20.6 MWh were consumed at a carbon emission total of 6,975 kg.

Ringsend terminal -24.8 MWh were consumed at a carbon emission of 8,402 kg.

Tarbert terminal -58.4 MWh were consumed with a total carbon emissions of 19,752 kg.

Energy Management Actions in 2019

- Ongoing commitment to SEAI energy M&R programme.
- Commitment to the practical, technical and behavioural adjustments necessary to achieve energy savings.
- Continued implementation of NORA's Energy Management Plan.
- NORA's Energy Performance was 32% better than 2020 Target
- Onsite Energy generated from renewable sources (Tarbert Solar Panels) in 2019 was 4.9 MWh.
