

### **Energy Management Obligations in 2019**

In 2019 NORA met its Public Body Energy Management obligations set out in [S.I. No. 426/2014 - European Union\(Energy Efficiency\) Regulations 2014](#)

NORA continues to pursue its energy saving targets for 2020 through participation in SEAI's system for Energy Monitoring and Reporting.

### **Overview of Energy Usage in 2019**

NORA's main energy use in 2019 was as follows:

NORA's office building – 20.6 MWh were consumed at a carbon emission total of 6,975 kg.

Ringsend terminal – 24.8 MWh were consumed at a carbon emission of 8,402 kg.

Tarbert terminal – 58.4 MWh were consumed with a total carbon emissions of 19,752 kg.

### **Energy Management Actions in 2019**

- Ongoing commitment to SEAI energy M&R programme.
- Commitment to the practical, technical and behavioural adjustments necessary to achieve energy savings.
- Continued implementation of NORA's Energy Management Plan.
- NORA's Energy Performance was 32% better than 2020 Target
- Onsite Energy generated from renewable sources (Tarbert Solar Panels) in 2019 was 4.9 MWh.
